Using the “Twister” Templates Part II

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- When cutting the two smaller (Itty Bitty & Primitive) templates an 18mm or 28mm rotary cutter is a necessity. The issue is not that what you’re cutting is too small, it’s just that they are kept very close to each other to **minimize** fabric waste.

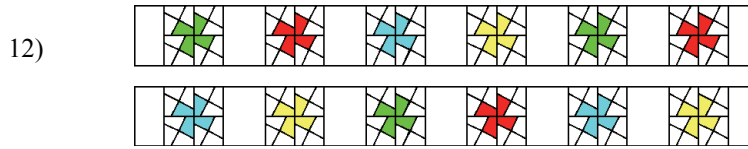
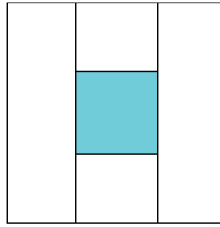
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Cutting Instructions

Background	Cut (3) 1½” x wof strips From (1) strip cut: Cut into (1) 1½” x 4½” rect. Cut into (1) 1½” x 1½” sq. Cut into (4) ¾” x ¾” sqs.	Cut (3) 2¼” x wof strips From (1) strip cut: Cut into (1) 2¼” x 2¼” sq. Cut into (1) 2¼” x 7½” rect. Cut into (4) 1” x 1” sqs.	Cut into (5) 3½” x wof strips From (1) strip cut: Cut into (1) 3½” x 3½” sq. Cut into (1) 3½” x 12½” rect. Cut into (4) 1½” x 1½” sqs.

- 7) Make single pinwheel blocks (used later on the borders) following the layout at right and using the size blocks and borders from Block Layout Table on Page #20.



- a) Create two pinwheel borders by separating 6 pinwheel blocks with **Background** fabric spacer rectangles (size shown below).
- b) Finish off the two pinwheel borders with an Endcap on each end (size shown below).
